The Artwork

'Lucky' is one of a series of sculptures created by
Desmond Scott out of his career-long passion and
involvement with Samuel Beckett's seminal play,
Waiting for Godot.

The Artist

One of the first directors at Winnipeg's Manitoba
Theatre Centre founded by John Hirsch and Tom
Hendry, Desmond Scott is a highly respected
Actor/Director/ Writer who, among other notable
accomplishments, produced the first professional
Canadian production of Samuel Beckett's "Waiting
for Godot" in 1958. Many years later, having
developed into a successful sculptor whose works
are found in many public and private collections in
Canada and abroad, he created a series of 'Godot'-
inspired sculptures, which garnered plaudits and
critical praise. This work is from that series.

Desmond Scott continues in his varied creative
pursuits. He is married to Corinne Langston, a
writer/musician/actress. They have a daughter,
Amanta (also an artist) and a son Dominic (in
business but occasionally plays trombone) and
reside in Toronto, Canada.
